- **Greetings.....**from Derbyshire where we are packing in as much outdoor learning as possible over the two day residential trip. Last evening we walked 4½ miles through Dovedale and this morning we are heading to Eyam to learn about the 1665 Plague.
- **The Friends of Huttoft School....**met on Friday to finalise arrangements for the Summer Fayre on Friday, 29<sup>th</sup> June commencing straight after school. It was decided to postpone the 'Garden Party' – originally fixed for 22<sup>nd</sup> June – until the Autumn term as part of welcoming our new children. A 'flyer' for the Fayre will follow but in the first instance gifts for the Raffle and Tombola stalls would be much appreciated, along with small items (to the value of 50p) for the Lucky Bag stall and bottles of wine and empty ones for the Wine and Water stall. Thank you.  
All the proceeds for the Fayre will go towards our Anderson Shelter Development fund.

The week's attendance fell to 93% and with it punctuality – to 90%. To succeed with punctuality the child/ren must be in class for 8:35am when Registers are taken. School, i.e. lessons commence at 8:35am and parents/carers should be leaving the premises then.  
Our school remains in the bottom 10% of Lincolnshire schools for attendance (average across the County is 96.2%) and in the bottom 5% for punctuality.
- **Sports Day.....**is Tuesday, 10<sup>th</sup> July. It begins at 10:50am and as always all the children will be involved in a set of traditional races, against their peers. There is a lunch break and we hope as many children as possible will book a 'Sports Day Picnic' via the school lunch menu. The FHS Refreshment Stall will be open along with our Second Hand Uniform Shop. Presentations will be in the Hall at approximately 2:30pm. Please may I remind you to park with consideration for the local residents. Sport Day is held on the 'top' field – i.e. at the end of the cul de sac.

- **Transition Days.....**on Monday and Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> June all the children will 'move' classes to their September one for both days enabling them to spend time with their next class teacher, staff and surroundings. The majority of Year 5 will be away in Shropshire on their School Journey with me, Mrs S Smalley and Mr Irving.  
Our September Reception Class children have already been notified of their Transition arrangements – half will join Miss Skinner on the Monday the other half on the Tuesday.  
Our current Reception children will be with Mrs Peet in Year 1; our current Year 1's will be in Year 2 with Miss Mullen – both classrooms are in the Meaker Suite.  
Our current Year 2's will be with Miss Lawrence, in the current Year 4 classroom and our current Year 3's will be with Mrs W Smalley, in their 'now' classroom. The Year 3 and Year 4 (lower junior) classrooms are changing over for next year.  
Year 6 will remain with Mrs Heald and the non-school journey Y5's will join her.
- **Nursery Toddle and Waddle.....**is on Wednesday, 4<sup>th</sup> July commencing at 1:40pm. We welcome all the Nursery parents/carers to join us as the children complete a walking circuit. Do bring a picnic to enjoy afterwards. Donations of cakes for a Cake Stall are always appreciated with funds raised going towards additional nursery equipment.
